You can also get there by taking 87 South to 85 North and exit on Almaden Expy, turn left to Blossom Hill and follow the directions above.

Quick job description: **Field Reset**

A part of the field crew. Field reset help prepare the playing field for every match during the entire competition. The playing field contains 60 balls, all of which needs to be placed at the proper position before the match begin.

Your group leaders: **2 Field Manager** - Two individuals who will be in charge of the playing field and matches with the help of a field crew.

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Let's take a look at the **Saturday schedule** before we go over what you need to do on the day of the event:

Saturday October 28th Schedule

07:00am: Pit Area open for teams; Registration and Inspection Open.

07:30am: "**Volunteer Check-In Table**" open for volunteers to sign in and receive **volunteer badge & meal ticket**.

08:30am: Team Representatives meeting on the playing field (1 per team).

08:45am: Opening Ceremony.

09:00am Beginning of **qualifying matches**.

01:00pm: *Approximate* End of **qualifying matches, beginning of lunch break**.

01:15pm: *Approximate* Aim High Alliance Selection

01:45pm: Beginning of **elimination rounds**.

04:15pm: The end of **elimination rounds**.

04:30pm: **Awards Ceremony**

05:00pm: Begin tear down and clean up.

When do you come in? What do you do when you arrive at Pioneer High School?

We are asking all volunteers to arrive no later than 8am on the morning of October 28th. When you arrive at PioneerHigh School, please head over to the **Volunteer Check-In Table** located in the mini gym where the **pit area** is. The table will be right next to the registration table where participating teams sign in. Talk to one of the **Volunteer Coordinators** and they will check you in and give you your **Volunteer Badge** and **meal ticket**. You cannot enter the playing field area without a **Volunteer Badge** or Team Badge. The Field Reset crew will receive a free lunch and drinks that day.

Then the **Volunteer Coordinator** will direct you to your group leader, in your case, **Jayne Sonnenschein from Team 1351 and Alvin Cheng from Team 581**. Your group leader will talk to you about your job and what you need to do, but here is a quick run down of your job as one of the Field Reset crew: You will each be assigned a position, either at the end of the field on the blue side or the red side, or on the remaining two side of the playing field. Each driver station will have a set number of soft poof balls, and each robot on the field will also be allowed to contain a set number of balls. The job of the field reset crew is to keep track of the number of balls at each position and make sure they are all there before the next match begins.

Your job will go on from **8:30am**, before qualifying matches begin, until **4:15pm**, when elimination rounds are over. There will be training sessions in the morning to help the field reset crew practice at resetting the field.
