If you are coming from the North, you would come down 85 to Almaden Expy. Turn Left after the exit and right onto Almaden heading toward Blossom Hill Rd. Turn right on Blossom Hill Rd and continue to the third light and make a left into the school go to the parking lot. You can also get there by taking 87 South to 85 North and exit on Almaden Expy, turn left to Blossom Hill and follow the directions above.

Quick job description: **Floor Protection (In the Main Gym)**

Floor protection is a very important part of the setup process because we have to make sure the Pioneer gym floor does not get damaged during the next two days while 6 130lbs robots competition in an intense game on top of it. Laying down the floor protecting is a very specific process. 1. We have to lay down the plastic sheets to protect the hard wood floor from any scratches made by foot traffic, the bottom of carpets, and anything else that might get dropped on the floor. 2. We have to lay down about 80 sheets of 1/8" wood boards directly underneath the playing field, to protect the floor from robots tipping over and making dents with their sharp corners. 3. We have to lay down the carpets to cover the entire gym floor. The carpets used under the playing field will be seamed with carpet seaming tapes using hot seaming irons. The rest of the carpets will be tapped together using a less sticky tape call Gaffer's Tape.

The entire process should take approximately 3 hours in the Main Gym of Pioneer High School. Floor Protection setup will be led by **Mike Scmit of Team 1351.**

Tools and Supplies needed:

We will be using carpet seaming tapes, carpet seaming irons, gaffer's tapes, and plywood handlers for this part of the setup.
