From HWY 280, take the Woodside Road exit. Take Woodside Road (going toward Redwood City/Atherton), for 0.8 mile, you will reach Churchill Ave.  
If you want to reach the **Main Parking Lot**, go past football field and turn left.  
From US-101 N, take exit 408 to merge onto Woodside Rd. Continue for 3.8 miles, you will reach Churchill Ave.  
From US-101 S, take exit 408 for Woodside Rd/CA-84 W. Continue for 3.2 miles, you will reach Churchill Ave.

#### Quick job description: **Field Reset**

A part of the field crew. Field reset help prepare the playing field for matches during the entire competition. The game requires 64 ringers to be kept in play, all of which needs to be placed at the proper position before the match begin. You will also need to help us with ringer repairs, and maintain traffic flow around the play field.

Your group leader, the Field Supervisor, will be in running the playing field the entire day, with the help of the field crew. So get ready for an exciting day because our goal is to finish on time, and in order to do that, we need the field crew to work as efficiently as possible.

08:00am: Volunteer training and mock matches.  
08:30am: Team Representatives meeting on the playing field (1 per team).  
09:00am: Opening Ceremony.  
09:15am: Beginning of **qualifying matches**.  
01:00pm: \*Approximate\* End of **qualifying matches, beginning of lunch break**.  
01:15pm: \*Approximate\* Rack n' Roll Alliance Selection  
01:30pm: \*Approximate\* Beginning of **elimination rounds**.  
04:15pm: The end of **elimination rounds**.  
04:30pm: **Awards Ceremony**  
05:00pm: Begin tear down and clean up.

#### When do you come in? What do you do when you arrive at Woodside High School?

---

We are asking all volunteers to arrive no later than 8am on the morning of October 13th. When you arrive at Woodside High School, please head over to the **Volunteer Check-In Table** located in the main gym where the playing field is. The table will be right next to the scoring table. We will hand out **Volunteer Badge** and meal ticket before our training session. You cannot enter the playing field area without a **Volunteer Badge** or Team Badge. The Field Reset will receive a free lunch and drinks that day.

You should also check in with your group leader, **Jayne Sonnenschein**. Jane will go over some key things with you, and work out the positions and responsibilities of each field reset for the rest of the day.

Your job will go on from **8:00am**, a little before qualifying matches begin, until **4:15pm**, when elimination rounds are over. After finish checking in at 8:00am, there will be a volunteer training session where will have several mock matches to let volunteers become familiar with their responsibilities.
