# Fire Hazard Detected



About 345,000 DeWalt Cordless Drills have been recalled by the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission because the trigger switch can overheat, posing a fire hazard.

The drills were sold at wholesale distributors and retailers between June 2006 and Dec. 2007. The recall involves drills with the following model numbers: DC920, DC930, DC935, DC936 and DC940.
