

Tax Credit Plan

- 1) Each team member is required to get a \$250 personal donation or they can't travel. (Does not include businesses)
- 2) Mail and ask everyone you know for a Tax Credit. Give them the letter and form and you **MUST** follow up with a call.
- 3) Ask parents and family to get some for you. Give them the letter and form to hand out.
- 4) After you get the Tax Credit you must send a thank you note and receipt for the contribution.

Now that our school year is in full swing, the Kingman High School Robotics Team would like to show you an exceptional opportunity for you to help out our school.

Arizona is fortunate to offer a tax credit on state taxes. This applies to ALL Arizona taxpayers. Any tax payer may contribute up to \$200.00 per individual or \$250.00 per couple, to any fee-required extra curricular activity offered at the school and club of their choice. This is a direct tax credit, not a deduction. **That means it is subtracted from the taxes you owe** and is fully refunded- for up to \$250.00. For example, if you regularly owe \$400.00 a year in Arizona state income tax and give \$250.00 to a school, you would only owe \$150.00 for the year you gave a tax credit. It literally costs you nothing to give the \$250.00. It comes back to you as a **credit, refund or reduction**.

This is a wonderful win/win situation. As a taxpayer you are able to reduce your tax burden while contributing directly to the Kingman High School Robotics Team. We can accept any amount from \$10.00 to \$250.00.

We urge you to help share this message with all Arizona tax payers, your friends, neighbors and relatives. It's time to take advantage of this ability to benefit our students.

TAX CREDIT

In 2003, an individual or family may receive a TAX CREDIT from the state of Arizona for any cash donation (up to \$250) to a school that charges a fee for extra-curricular activities. Up to \$250 may be given for a married couple filing jointly or \$200 for a single individual filing as head of household. This means that the amount donated comes right off the top of the Arizona State income tax bill for 2003. If you itemize on your federal income tax return, then the donation

would also be a deduction for a charitable contribution.
