

Amigurumi Crochet Dozer

Design by VanNerd1128#2588 on Discord, VanNerd on CD

Supplies:

Blue yarn
Grey yarn
White yarn
Black embroidery floss
Yarn needle
3.0mm crochet hook
3.5mm crochet hook
Some stuffing

Notes:

-Dozer the character does not belong to me, which means crocheted dozers cannot be sold. Dozer the character belongs to Dave Lavery.
-I have made these instructions as simple as I can, if you are an experienced crocheter, understand that these instructions were made to be as easy to understand as possible
-If something doesn't make sense just DM me on discord or CD.

Abbreviations:

Ch - chain
Sc - single crochet
Mc - magic circle
Sc2tog - single crochet 2 together
Sc3tog - single crochet 3 together
Ss - slip stitch
BLO - back loop only



Body

Use the 3.5mm hook and the blue yarn

Row 1: Ch 4, work 1 sc into the ch second to the hook, sc 2, ch2, sc into the same ch as the last sc, ch2, sc into the same ch as before, sc2 into back of chain, c2, sc into same spot as last sc, c2, ss into first sc. (16)

Row 2: Ch1, sc4, ch2, sc3, ch2, sc5, c2, sc3, ch2, sc1, ss into first stitch. (24)

Row 3: Ch1, sc5, ch2, sc5, ch2, sc7, ch2, sc5, ch2, sc2, ss into first stitch. (32)

Row 4: BLO Ch1, sc32, ss into first stitch. (32)

Rows 5-7: Ch1, sc32, ss into first stitch. (32)

Row 8: BLO Ch1, sc5, sc3tog, sc4, sc3tog, sc6, sc3tog, sc4, sc3tog, sc1, ss into first stitch. (24)

Row 9: Ch1, sc4, sc3tog, sc2, sc3tog, sc4, sc3tog, sc2, sc3tog, ss into first stitch. (16)

STUFF

Row 10: Ch1, sc3, sc3tog, sc3tog, sc2, sc3tog, sc3tog but end with a ss*. (8)

Sew the two sides of 4 stitches each together with the end of the blue yarn

*if that doesn't make sense just sc2tog and then ss into the first stitch.

Plow

Use the grey yarn and the 3.5mm hook

Row 1: Ch8, sc7 starting at the second ch from hook. (7)

Rows 2-6: Ch1, sc7. (7)

Finish off the last stitch, you should have a rectangle about as wide and slightly taller than the body. Sew the plow on using the grey yarn, and only going through rows 4 and 5 (this will allow the plow to curl out at the bottom and top, more so at the bottom).

Wheels

Use the grey yarn and 3.5mm hook

Make 6 mc of 6sc each, ss into the first stitch at the end of each.

Use the ends of yarn on each mc to sew on three wheels on each side.

Eyes

Use the white yarn and 3.0mm hook

Make 2 mc of 5 sc each, ss into the first stitch at the end of each.

Cut two 8 inch pieces of black embroidery floss. Tie it in a knot 4 times in the middle of the piece, repeat with the other thread. Sew the knots on each mc to finish the eyes. Use the ends of the white yarn to sew the eyes on in the top corners of the plow, try to avoid sewing into the blue body.

Congratulations! Your dozer is complete!
