

DOZER SEWING GUIDE

ARYNAPRIL #4982 ON DISCORD + PLANETBRILLIANT ON CD

Tools needed:

- Sewing needle
- Thread (blue for the body, grey for the plow if you wanna get fancy)
- A scrap of blue fleece (at least 10.5x3)
- A scrap of grey fleece (at least 4x3)
- 6 small white buttons (around 1cm diameter, close to there, exacts don't matter much)
- 2 small googly eyes (same as the buttons)
- White embroidery Floss
- Superglue

Vague Instructions:

- 1) Cut out a 10.5x3 block of blue fleece, which you will then mark and cut according to the diagram on the right
- 2) Cut a small, inch long slit in one of the front/back pieces (as labeled on right). You'll use this to stuff it later.
- 3) Sew together the dozer into a basic rectangular prism esque shape using whichever stitch you prefer (I use the whip stitch)
- 4) Turn inside out through slit, stuff, and sew slit shut.
- 5) Sew on buttons, 3 to each side, using embroidery floss.
- 6) Cut out two 2x3 pieces of grey fleece
- 7) Cut a small, inch long slit in one of these pieces. You'll use this to turn and stuff it.
- 8) Sew the two pieces together along the outside edge.
- 9) Turn inside out through slit, stuff, and sew slit shut
- 10) Slit seams facing each other, sew plow to chassis. I usually sew together the seam parts first, then sew around the back of the plow/front of the chassis in a circle around the two slits (one stitch through the plow, one through the chassis, repeat, until you've circled around the back of the plow/front of the chassis, kind of like a ladder stitch)
- 11) Glue googly eyes to plow.
- 12) Enjoy your small new friend and treat him well.
